ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2014-42(b)

An Ordinance Proposing an Amendment to the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska Authorizing the Creation of an Empowered Board to Operate and Manage the Municipally-Owned ~~Pools~~ Aquatics Facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska.

Section 2. Charter Amendment. The Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska is amended by adding a new section 3.23, ~~Pool~~ Aquatics board, to read as follows:

Section 3.23. ~~Pool~~ Aquatics board. The assembly may establish a board of directors for the municipally-owned and operated ~~pools~~ aquatics facilities, and appoint members to the board. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3.16 of this Charter, the board shall derive its authority and power from the assembly by ordinance.

Section 3. Submission of Question to the Voters. An amendment to add a new Section 3.23 to the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska shall be submitted to the voters of the City and Borough at the next regular municipal election. The

1 Municipal Clerk shall prepare the ballot and perform all necessary steps in accordance with
2 law to place this proposition before the qualified voters at the next regular municipal
3 election.

6 **Section 4. Proposition.** The proposition to be submitted to the qualified voters of the
7 City and Borough, as required by Section 3, shall read substantially as follows:

12 Shall the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska be
13 amended by adding a new Section 3.23, ~~Pool~~ Aquatics board, to read as
14 follows:

17 **Section 3.23. ~~Pool~~ Aquatics board.** The assembly may establish a board of
18 directors for the municipally-owned and operated ~~pools~~ aquatics facilities, and
19 appoint members to the board. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section
20 3.16 of this Charter, the board shall derive its authority and power from the
21 assembly by ordinance.

25 **Section 5. Effective Date.** (a) The Charter amendment proposed in Section 2 of this
26 ordinance shall become effective on the day following the date the election results are
27

1 certified for the regular municipal election held on October 7, 2014, if approved by a
2 majority of the qualified voters of the City and Borough voting on the question set forth in
3 Section 4.

4 (b) Sections 3 and 4 of this ordinance of this ordinance authorizing the submission of the
5 ballot proposition to the qualified voters of the City and Borough shall become effective 30
6 days after adoption of this ordinance.
