ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2019-01

An Ordinance Amending the City and Borough Code Relating to the Criminal Penalty for Violating Conditions of Release.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. CBJ 42.05.110 Violation of condition of release, is amended to read:

- (a) A person commits the crime of violation of condition of release if the person
 - (1) has been charged with a crime or convicted of a crime;
 - (2) has been released under AS 12.30; and
 - (3) violates a condition of release imposed by a judicial officer under AS 12.30, other than the requirement to appear as ordered by a judicial officer.
- (b) Violation of condition of release is a Class B misdemeanor and is punishable by a term of imprisonment of not more than five days and a fine of not more than \$2,000.00.
