14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, opioid impacts have resulted in increased criminal justice law enforcement demands, increased healthcare demands - including behavioral healthcare - increased emergency medical services demands, increased educational supportive services demands and increased emergency and transitional housing services demands; and			
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, municipalities in Alaska are uniquely suited to help utilize or distribut opioid settlement funds because of the array of services provided by municipalities and by local providers; and			
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, opioid settlement funds should be available to reimburse existing and create new opioid related municipal services - like services for people experiencing homelessness, police, fire/EMS, behavioral health, and other healthcare - and grants to local providers who provide opioid support services; and

34 35 36 37	Whereas, upon balancing the opioid impacts across the State of Alaska and the desire to help resolve the current opioid litigation, it is in the interest of all to maximize the amount of settlement funding that will come to the state; and			
38 39 40	WHEREAS, the municipalities in Alaska encourage the State of Alaska to create an opioid settlement distribution that provides stable short-term and long-term funding to abate			

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the opioid impacts in Alaska's municipalities.
