Consistent with the December 1, 2014, Pre-Hearing Order, the parties jointly file this statement of issues on appeal. The parties reserve the right to include and argue sub-issues.

Issues:

- Whether the unlisted use decision complied with CBJ 49.20.320 as evaluated by CBJ 01.50.070. (Appellants' Issues #1-5, 9, and 10).
- Whether the conditional use decision complied with CBJ 49.15.330 as evaluated by CBJ 01.50.070. (Appellants' Issues # 7-8).

The parties agree that the Assembly, acting in its quasi-judicial capacity under CBJ 01.50.020 and CBJ 49.20.120, does not have jurisdiction to decide whether a code provision or decision is constitutional. E.g., Alaska Public Interest Research Group v. State, 167 P.3d 27, 36 12/16/14 Stipulation of Issues

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(2007) ("Administrative agencies do not have jurisdiction to decide issues of constitutional law."). However, the following issues have been preserved, if necessary, if a party properly commences an action in superior court:

- a. Whether CBJ 49.20.320 is constitutional. (Appellants' Issue #6).
- b. Whether the unlisted use decision is constitutional. (Appellants' Issue #9)

The Appellants withdraw their Joint Stipulation of Issues on Appeal that was filed on December 15, 2014. The parties sign and approve this form consistent with Hearing Officer's Pre-Hearing Order requiring this joint statement of issues.
