Bids were opened on the subject project on September 15, 2015. Upon review of the specification the award posting occurred on September 16, 2015. The bid protest period expired at 4:30 p.m. on September 17, 2015. Results of the bid opening are as follows:

With the concurrence of Rorie Watt, Public Works Director, the Purchasing Division recommends award to Gillig LLC on the basis of having the lowest responsive and responsible bid price. Gillig submitted their bid for 3 buses at a cost of \$369,308.00 for each bus, with a total bid of \$1,107,924.00. Capital Transit plans to purchase 4 buses at the Base Bid price of \$369,308.00 each for a total amount of \$1,477,232.00. The Added Alternate Optional item, Safety Vision Camera system will be considered if funds in the Grant allow. The pricing for the Optional Camera system submitted is \$5,831.00 each with a total possible expense for 4 of \$23,324.00. This would bring the total of the 4 buses with camera systems to \$1,500,556.00.
